

SUMMARY ANNUAL REPORT

For OREGON PUBLIC EMPLOYEES UNION MEMBER LIFE PLAN

This is a summary of the annual report of the OREGON PUBLIC EMPLOYEES UNION MEMBER LIFE PLAN, EIN 93-0323147, Plan No. 503, for period January 01, 2018 through December 31, 2018. The annual report has been filed with the Employee Benefits Security Administration, U.S. Department of Labor, as required under the Employee Retirement Income Security Act of 1974 (ERISA).

Insurance Information

The plan has contracts with Arag Insurance Company and Lifemap Assurance Company to pay life insurance, temporary disability and legal claims incurred under the terms of the plan. The total premiums paid for the plan year ending December 31, 2018 were \$1,042,329.

Because they are so called "experience-rated" contracts, the premium costs are affected by, among other things, the number and size of claims. Of the total insurance premiums paid for the plan year ending December 31, 2018, the premiums paid under such "experience-rated" contracts were \$592,275 and the total of all benefit claims paid under these contracts during the plan year was \$292,283.

If you request a copy of the full annual report from the plan administrator, these two statements and accompanying notes will be included as part of that report. The charge to cover copying costs given above does not include a charge for the copying of these portions of the report because these portions are furnished without charge.

You also have the legally protected right to examine the annual report at the main office of the plan (SEIU LOCAL 503, OPEU, PO BOX 12159, SALEM, OR 97309-0159) and at the U.S. Department of Labor in Washington, D.C., or to obtain a copy from the U.S. Department of Labor upon payment of copying costs.
