State & Higher Ed

 **\$421.51 per month.** That's the extra money in your pocket each month (on average) thanks to the **healthcare benefits** negotiated in our contract.


 **\$431 per month.** That's the extra money in your **retirement** account each month (on average) thanks to our contract.

 **Representation.** Union members are there for each other when we need it most, like when facing false accusations or wrongful termination. **Stewards** at worksites around the state, and the **Member Resource Center** at SEIU offices, are there for you.

Local Government

 **\$440 per month.** That's the **extra money you're paid per month** (on average) compared to non-union local government workers throughout the country.

 **10 days.** The number of **vacation days** accrued (on average) by our contracts in the first year of employment (accrual amount increases over time).

 **7.8 hours.** The hours of **sick pay** (on average) our contracts accrue for each month worked.
