#### Local 140 updates

We had our monthly membership meeting this past Saturday. Items included the upcoming bargaining process, approval of a social media committee to launch a union instagram page, and approval of new stewards. Also a reminder to look for an email from SEIU to nominate yourself or a coworker for the open custodial representative at-large position on our leadership team. ## **Bargaining outlook**

We will begin bargaining with the district no later than February 10th, though the district has not yet confirmed the date of our first meeting. The bargaining team will meet this coming Saturday to discuss the results of the bargaining survey and develop a strategy and demands for the upcoming negotiations with the district. If you have not already, please complete the <u>survey</u> so we can hear from as many members as possible! The district is already announcing that they will be short \$50 million for the upcoming budget, however, their fear-mongering does not excuse them from paying a livable wage and addressing the needs of all their employees. We will keep members informed of the bargaining process as it unfolds and will need everyone's input and support to make the district agree to our demands. Please reach out to your bargaining delegates if you have any questions or input.
