COVID Leave Campaign

Since our COVID leave agreement expired June 30th, the district has been unwilling to come to the table to bargain for a renewed agreement. This week, representatives from many unions in our union coalition will be speaking before the board to protest the district's inaction on this issue. We will also formally present the board with over 700 signatures we have collected on our COVID leave <u>petition</u>.

Please show up to the Prophet Education Service Center (formerly BESC) at 6pm, Tuesday 10/11 to support! If you are working then or unable to attend, you can still send in a picture to add to our photo petition. If you cannot attend in person, you can also stream the board meeting here.

The Portland Federation of School Professionals (PFSP) representing classified employees is also organizing a rally outside Atkinson Elementary during back-to-school night on Wednesday 10/12 at 6:15pm. This is another opportunity to show up in support of COVID leave and show solidarity with PFSP workers who are also calling attention to the continued staffing crisis.

It is shameful that PPS has refused to negotiate over this important issue for this long. Since July 1st, many employees have been forced to use all their paid leave and even go unpaid to stay home with COVID. We know that COVID is still spreading in our communities and is predicted to rise again this winter. Now is the time to work together to demand that PPS take care of its workers and provide us with paid COVID leave!
