DID YOU KNOW?

MARION COUNTY DOESN'T PROVIDE AFFORDABLE HEALTH INSURANCE TO THE WORKERS WHO SERVE YOU

The people who protect children, provide public health services, maintain roads and parks, and support families might go on strike to get affordable health insurance and fair wages. *Here's why.*

- Many workers already pay up to \$461/month for family health insurance.
- Premiums are rising again in January and are expected to increase in 2028 at the same unsustainable rate.
- The County has proposed contributing \$50 more for the remainder of 2026, and \$204 more per month in 2027. If premiums increase at the same rate then by 2028 costs to employees could be over \$500 per month for insurance, consuming the entire 2% COLA the County is willing to offer.
- The County's wage offer continues to fall well behind the cost of living.

When Marion County can't recruit and retain experienced workers, our entire community feels the impact.
